All information regarding your child’s classes will be sent by email. Please write legibly so that the emails and information arrive without problems.

GENERAL INFORMATION

FISH (Faith Initiative Starts at Home) is Corpus Christi’s faith formation program for children in grades 1 through 5. FISH offers Wednesday Classes or Home-Study. **Registration is required for both options.** Children must also be re-registered each year.

Wednesday classes will be offered once per week on Wednesdays, September – May, 4:30pm-5:45pm.

- Children must be signed in and out of each class by a designated adult. Children must be walked to their designated class and picked up from their class area. Children will NOT be permitted to meet their parents or legal guardian at the car.
- When a child will be absent, the family needs to email the Director of Faith Formation for Children (Maria Inciong) and/or the catechist. If a child misses a Wednesday class, he/she must complete an online interactive review for that lesson.

Home-Study is offered to families who are not able to bring their child to a Wednesday class at the time offered. Children will work from the FISH Wednesday Class/Home Study calendar and will email weekly Loyola Press “Finding God” Interactive Session results to FISH Team at ccfishav@gmail.com.

Requirements for Wednesday Class and Home-Study families:

- **Students and at least one parent/guardian are required to attend a minimum of 3 Family Intergenerational Events per FISH year.** All must be present during whole Family Intergenerational Event (Opening, Saint and Parent Sessions, Closing). These fun and faith-filled events will incorporate the whole family and be enriching to the faith formation process. These events will be offered periodically throughout the FISH calendar year on Sundays from 1pm-3pm. There are five Family Intergenerational Events based on the five units of the Loyola Press *Finding God* textbooks. Each Intergenerational Event is composed of the Opening, Saint and Parent Session, and Closing.

Faith Formation is a lifelong process. Even after children receive the sacraments, they are encouraged to continue with the FISH program until they move into Youth Ministry’s Middle School (EDGE) and High School (LifeTeen) programs.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION (Grades 1st – 5th)

For children who **have been baptized and are in Grades 1st – 5th, preparation for First Reconciliation and Holy Eucharist begins in 1st grade** (or any grade after) and is a **two-consecutive year process**. They will need to be registered and participate in the FISH program for two consecutive years. *Baptism certificates MUST be turned in with registration or within 1 month of registering for Sacramental Preparation.*

For children who are **NOT baptized Roman Catholic** and are at least 7 years of age, they will need to be registered and participate in the FISH program for two consecutive years. During the second year of FISH, the child will be formally prepared for the sacraments (Baptism, First Communion & Confirmation) through the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) Adapted for Children. (NOTE: Older children in Grades 6th – 12th need to contact our Director of Youth Ministry, George Vasquez.

Parents whose FISH children are preparing for First Reconciliation and First Eucharist, through Wednesday Class or Home Study, are **required to attend a:**

1. **Minimum of 1 Parish Class (starting with Class 101) OR Parent Orientation Retreat**
2. **Minimum of 3 Intergenerational Events (attended with FISH children and other immediate family members) each year** FISH children are enrolled in Sacramental Preparation.

General Consequences

2. Receiving a time-out during class. Taken aside to talk about concerns.
3. A meeting with the student and Program Director. Parents will be notified of the issue. Student will call parent to be picked up/make-up work given and student will complete all lessons by Home Study.

Serious/Continued offenses

Parents will be called to pick up student from class. A meeting will be scheduled with parents, student and Program Director about alternative options to fulfill the grade level requirements.

SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION REQUIREMENTS (for Year 2 students ONLY)

First Reconciliation and First Eucharist are received by FISH Year 2 Sacramental Preparation students only after:

1. FISH Registration form has been completed on a yearly basis and necessary fees have been paid.
2. Parents attend a Parent Orientation Retreat or a minimum of one Parish Class (starting with Class 101).
3. Student completes two (2) consecutive years of FISH (Home Study and/or Wednesday Class) Faith Formation program.
4. FISH team obtains Online Interactive Session Reviews from all Home Study students and from Wednesday Class students when absent:
 - a. For FISH Wednesday Class Students:
 - if absent, student must complete the online Loyola Press “Finding God” Interactive Session for lesson missed and submit via email to Faith Formation team (via ccfishav@gmail.com).
 - b. For FISH Home Study students:
 - all Loyola Press “Finding God” Interactive Sessions must be submitted via email to Faith Formation team (via ccfishav@gmail.com).
 -
5. At least one parent AND student attend a minimum of three out of the five Family Intergenerational Events per year → total of 6 events for 2 years.
 - Attendance requires at least one parent and student to be present during event Opening, Saint and Parent Sessions, and Closing.
 - Sign-ups for the Family Intergenerational Events occur via email. An invitation email is sent by the FISH team 3 weeks before the event for parents to sign-up their family members and student.
6. Student completes Reconciliation and Eucharist workbooks before the Sacramental Preparation Retreat.
7. At least one parent AND student attend the Sacramental Preparation Retreat.
 - Sign-ups for the Sacramental Preparation Retreat will occur by the end of April (after the last Intergenerational Event and after determining the students who have fulfilled all the First Reconciliation and First Eucharist requirements). An email will be sent notifying parents to sign-up. At least one parent with student are required to attend the retreat.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- First Reconciliation needs to occur before the student can receive First Eucharist.
- After submitting all make-up activities, workbooks, and other necessary documents such as copy of the baptismal certificate, *parents can schedule during the Sacramental Preparation Retreat their child’s First Eucharist Mass time on the scheduled First Eucharist group dates or at any other Sunday Mass time during the year.*

WHEN REQUIREMENTS ARE NOT MET

Intergenerational Events (3 per FISH year → 6 required during 2 FISH years)

(Note: There are 5 Intergenerational Events per FISH year. They occur normally after the 12noon Mass from 1pm-3pm with lunch provided. Family members of all ages are welcome. We gather as a faith family to have lunch, discuss, learn, and engage in activities.)

If 3 of 5 events or 6 of 10 events for Year 2 are missed:

- 1 out of 6 → Mass DVD/worksheet to be turned in
- 2 out of 6 → Mass DVD/worksheet to be turned in and 2 CLOW Mass Time sessions as Lay Presider by parent with student attending
- 3 out of 6 → Mass DVD/worksheet to be turned in + 4 CLOW Mass Time sessions as Lay Presider by parent with student attending
- If more than 3 missed, please contact Maria Inciong, Director of Faith Formation for Children

Student Wednesday Class Absences (3 per FISH year allowed)

If unexcused absences exceed 3, for each additional unexcused absence:

- Student will need to attend 2 Children’s Liturgy Of the Word (CLOW) Mass Time sessions
- OR take Session Assessment for last session student was absent and turn-in at the Parish Office (office hours: Monday-Friday 9am-2pm) one week before the Sacramental Preparation Retreat date
- OR re-register for next FISH year for Faith Formation and Sacramental Preparation

Home Study Student Missed Online Interactive Sessions

– All online interactive sessions MUST be submitted via email to Faith Formation team by the end of April AND prior to the Sacramental Preparation Retreat.

- Note: The online interactive sessions are quick and fun ways for the students to learn more about the week’s lesson. The interactive sessions are from Loyola Press and emailing to you then forwarding to us, FISH Faith Formation Team via ccfishav@gmail.com.
