Summary

The purpose of this position, under the direction of the Technical Director, is to assist in the video requirements of the weekend experience.

Big Picture

- Operate camera(s) for Sunday Mass (10 AM) and other important Masses
- Review footage with TD for training purposes
- Operate camera(s) for special events

Details

Operate camera for Sunday Mass (10 AM)

- Setup and take down of Camera equipment as needed
- Following the direction of the video director, capture the liturgical portions of the weekend Mass including priest, processions, homily, cantor, lectors, etc.
- Maintain attention throughout the Mass

Review service footage with TD or Video Director for training purposes

- When possible, after Mass, review the footage with the director to improve timing, composition and transitions of shots

Operate camera for special events

- Based on availability, capture special events such as Holy Days, Good Friday, Christmas or Christmas Eve, etc.

Time Requirements

- 9:20 AM-11:20 PM Sundays
- Camera operators may be placed on weekly rotation depending on number and availability of other camera operators. It is expected that once you commit to the team that you make every effort to be there when scheduled.
- The duration of the commitment is a ministry year; August-July.

Physical Demands:

The Camera Operator must possess mobility to work in a video production equipped environment while also maintaining an appropriate reverence for the Liturgy. Camera Operator must be comfortable around technology including: computer, keyboard, camera and camera accessories, batteries, storage media, camera controls, onscreen touch displays, cable management, Specific vision abilities required by this job include vision to see a video monitor, color vision and depth perception; hearing and speech to communicate in person. The Camera Operator must also frequently use hands to finger, handle or feel objects, controls. The Camera Operator must possess mobility to walk up and down stairs, bend down, and stand/sit in position for extended periods of time.
