Summary

The purpose of this position, under the direction of the Technical Director, is to assist in the Livestream and video camera switching requirements of the weekend experience.

Big Picture

- Live Stream Sunday Mass (10 AM) and other important Masses events to our social media platforms
- Switch between Camera angles / slide presentation

Details

Operate Live Stream and Switching Software for Sunday Mass (10 AM)

- Turn on Computers, software and equipment and Setup Live Stream
- Check that all aspects of livestream production is working and ready such as ATEM software, cameras, slides, and audio
- Rehearse and Coordinate with Propresenter Operator and Camera Operator
- Monitor Audio for Live Stream in coordination with Audio Engineer
- Maintain attention throughout the Mass
- Use Atem software and StreamDeck to switch between cameras and slides throughout the Mass to provide best livestream experience.
- Stop Live Stream and tag/edit/publish stream to media platforms

Review Stream with TD, Camera Op, and Propresenter OP

- When possible, after Mass, review the live stream footage with the director to improve timing, composition and transitions of shots

Operate Live Stream for special events

- Based on availability, Stream special events such as Holy Days, Good Friday, Christmas or Christmas Eve

Qualifications:

- A committed, growing follower of Jesus Christ
- Authentic and consistent in his/her own spiritual walk and relationships
- A desire to learn and develop techniques for live video production including monitoring, switching, composition, framing, movement and transitions.
- Ability to follow verbal instructions and stay focused during the Mass

Time Requirements

- 9:20 AM-11:20 PM Sundays
- May be placed on weekly rotation depending on number and availability of other LiveStream operators. It is expected that once you commit to the team that you make every effort to be there when scheduled.
- The duration of the commitment is a ministry year; August-July.

Physical Demands:

The Live Stream video Operator must possess mobility to work in a live video production equipped environment while also maintaining an appropriate reverence for the Liturgy. Live Stream Operator must be comfortable around technology including: computer, keyboard, mouse, StreamDeck hardware, OBS streaming software, YouTube Studio/Facebook streaming platforms, ATEM switching software, storage media, camera controls. Specific vision abilities required by this job include vision to see a video monitor, color vision and depth perception; hearing and speech to communicate in person. The Live Stream Operator must also frequently use hands to finger, handle or feel objects, controls. The Live Stream Operator must possess mobility to walk up and down stairs, and sit in position for extended periods of time.
